RODNEY COLLEGE PAYMENTS 2024

Rodney College has opted-in to the Government's Donations Scheme, and as a result we will not be asking parents and caregivers for a school donation in the 2024 school year.

However, under this scheme we are permitted to ask for contributions to school camps/trips and these contributions may be claimed as a tax credit. Additionally, there will still be a charge for materials in subjects with a 'take home' component. eg wood, textiles, metal technology etc.

There will also be a charge for any resources and stationery purchased through the school eg optional workbooks. Optional activities will continue to incur a charge eg sports, cultural, ball.

All charges and contribution requests will be applied to the student's college account.

Our preferred method of payment for contributions is an Automatic Payment (AP) which can be set up from as little as \$5 per week. We strongly urge you to set up an AP for your child.

Payments can also be made to the student office by cash, cheque, eftpos, credit card, or online banking.
